"Undo Your Unkind Deeds"
"HATRED CREATES the greatest unhappiness within you," said that noted psychologist Felix Adler. Then he said, "If you do a wrong to someone you will come to hate him. Maybe he won't know anything about it but you will. Why will you come to hate him? Because everytime you think of him you will have a twinge of conscience; bitterness will be aroused within you; you will think a little less of yourself. And the misery within you will be caused by seeing yourself in an unsatisfactory light."

Just how would you work out of such a situation? If you have been unjust to a man, maybe unknown to him, what can you do about it? Only you can decide that. But Dr. Adler thought that you could always repair a damage. Perhaps the wronged man doesn't even need to know about it. Perhaps you can actually undo the deed that caused the difficulty. If you can't do exactly that, the chances are good you can counteract your deed by doing him a good turn now.

After you have done your former so-thought-of-enemy a good turn, see whether you don't actually like him a little better; see whether you don't like yourself a whole lot better. It would be interesting to hear from you if you have needed, and if you act upon, Dr. Adler's philosophy. As an experiment, try it out, see what effect it has on you, note whether you are a happier man afterward, and let's help out other readers of this column by telling your experience.
