**"I REMEMBER"**  
BY THE OLD TIMERS

From William E. Thompson, Stevens, S.D.: I remember attending a country school three miles from my farm home in Ireland. Most of the way there and return I was carried "pick-a-back" by older boys and girls. We used brown slivers of soft stone from a creek as pencil to write on slates.

From Mrs. Will Massey, Somers, Ky.: My mother, after drying apples, would knit about 150 pairs of wool socks and take them to the city. Father and mother would drive a wagon drawn by oxen. The load of apples and socks would bring them two or three hundred dollars. They would bring home a barrel of sugar, keg of coffee and enough other staples to last the winter, and enough material to make the boys suits and girls clothes for the winter. That's the way we used to live back in good old Republican days.

From Carl Rice, Big Cabin, Okla.: I remember when Hidalgo, Ill. was called Mudsuck. Aunt Kate Briggs ran the post office. Mr. Heath ran the store, and Bill Light ran a taxi with his favorite horse. When the first telephone was installed, Uncle Sam Weaver saw the boys working on the line and told them you couldn't talk through the wire because it wasn't hollow.

From Amos Harris, Eufaula, Okla.: I remember when I saw my first sawmill. It was pulled by a yoke of oxen which went around a gin pole while the long heavy rip saw sawed up and down. Logs were hauled by two-wheeled ox carts with wheels seven feet high. One end of the log was swung under the axle and the other end was let drag.
