A-The inheritance tax is regarded as a death tax since it becomes payable, only upon the death of a person.


Q-Were all the recommendations of the Joint Committee on Organia tion enacted into law by passage of the Legislative Reorganization

A-No. Some of the important recommendations not adopted included a joint legislative-executive council; a Congressional personnel office; a stenographic pool; an administrative assistant for every member; creation of a formal policy committee. The Senate acquired authority, since passage of the act to employ administrative


Q-Are committee records and files open to public inspection

A-No. They are property of Congress, and are accessible to any member of either house.

Q-What is the difference between a "Bill" and an "Act" in Congress? A-"Bill" is the technical designation of a measure introduced in either House. After a Bill has been passed by one House, it becomes an Act of that House. If it is passed by Both houses, it becomes an Act of Congress, even if not approved by the President.
