

Upon successful completion of Naval Science courses and other university studies, the midshipmen will be commissioned Ensigns, USNR, or Second Lieutenants, USMCR.

Johnnie Wyatt, son of Mr. and Mrs. Preston Wyatt of Route 2, Burnsville, is scheduled to graduate from recruit training November 23 at the Naval Training Center at Great Lakes, Ill.

The nine weeks of "Boot Camp" includes drill and instruction in seamanship, gunnery, life saving, sea survival, boat handling, and the use of small arms.

Specialist Third Class James D. Simmons, 19, son of Mr. and Mrs. Addern Simmons of Hamrick, is participating in Exercise Sage Brush in Louisiana.

Simmons, a member of Company A in the 82d Airborne Division's 782d Ordnance Battalion, is regularly stationed at Fort Bragg. He entered the Army in May 1954 and received basic training at Fort Jackson, S. C.
