Rabies Clinic Scheduled Saturday

A rabies clinic will be held at the Animal Shelter, located 3 1/2 miles east of Burnsville on the Mine Fork road, on Saturday, April 19 from 1:00 to 3:00 p. m. According to R. B. Dayton, dog warden, there are still about 50 per cent of the dogs in Yancey County that haven't been vaccinated. Mr. Dayton would like to encourage everyone who owns a pet to have it vaccinated against rabies. The price for vaccination, which will last for three years, is only \$1.00 per animal.

According to the North Carolina law, every dog must be vaccinated against rabies by the time he is six months old. Don't wait - The child that is bitten may be your own.

4-H's Receive Strawberry Plants

Seven Yancey County 4-H Club members received their orders of 1700 Tennessee Beauty strawberry plants last week, according to Assistant County Agent Roger Hyatt. These 4-H's believe that they can produce strawberries for the home and also, if they do a good job, produce some for sale in their communities, Mr. Hyatt said.

When these club members received their plants, they were advised to set the plants in rows four feet apart. The plants should be two feet apart in the row and fertilized with 800 lbs. per acre of 8-8-8 fertilizer. Strawberry plants should be set deep enough so that all roots are covered, but shallow enough so the crown is above the soil line.

The 4-H's, who stay in strawberry production year after year, will find this crop about as profitable as any other crop on the farm, Mr. Hyatt stated.
