This autumn's pumpkin pie is likely to have a wonderfully subtle flavor in addition to its usual spicy goodness. You couldn't guess if you didn't know—it's Sherry. The rich and mellow flavor of California Sherry seems to enhance the taste of all ingredients, Individual tarts have a party air, but this same mixture can be put into one large baked pie shell, if desired. 2 cups canned pumpkin 4 cup brown sugar teaspoon salt teaspoon cinnamon teaspoon ginger teaspoon cloves

½ cup light cream
½ cup California Sherry

Mix pumpkin, sugar, salt, and spices; add eggs, milk, cream and Sherry; beat with a rotary beater until well blended. Pour mixture into unbaked tart shells. Bake in a hot oven (425 degrees F.) for 20 minutes; reduce heat to moderate (350 degrees F.) and bake about 20 minutes longer, or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool. Serve topped with Sherry-Nutmeg Cream (below).

Sherry-Nutnieg Cream: Whip 1 ½ cups heavy cream just until thick and shiny; gently stir in 2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar, 1 to 2 tablespoons California Sherry and ¼ teast on nutmeg.


