NORTH CAROLINA YANCEY COUNTY AN ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUE OF \$400,000 REFUNDING BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF YANCEY, NORTH CAROLINA.

Be it ordered by the Board of Commissioners for the county of Yancey, North Carolina as follows:

1. Bonds of the county of Yancey shall be issued in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$400,000 pursuant to The County Finance Act for the purpose of refunding valid outstanding bonded indebtedness of the county incurred for a necessary expense and a special purpose within the meaning of the constitution, the indebtedness to be refunded being represented by a like amount of the \$413,000 General Refunding Bonds of the county currently bearing interest at the rate of four per cent per annum, dated July 1, 1938, payable July 1, 1973, or on such earlier date as they may be duly called for redemption and reciting that they are issued pursuant to The County Finance Act for the purpose of refunding valid outstanding indebtedness of the county incurred for a necessary expense and a special purpose within the meaning of the constitution; all of the said outstanding bonds to be called for redemption on July 1, 1963.

2. A tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest of the bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected.

3. A statement of the county debt incurred or to be incurred for other than school purposes has been filed with the clerk, and is open to public inspection.
