Soil Conservation Agency Runs Tests For Yancey Landowners

Farmers are not the only ones who can profit from a soil survey being made in the Yancey County Soil and Water Conservation District, according to Bert Sutton of the Soil Conservation Service at Burnsville. Soil scientists are mapping land in the County at the landowners' request. They examine the soil at frequent intervals, and plot the various kinds on aerial photographic maps.

A new leaflet issued by the Soil Conservation Service and the N. C. Agricultural Experiment Station lists a large number of uses that can be made of the information shown on the soil survey. "Anyone who has a financial interest in the land should be interested in basic soil information. Anyone who plans to dig a basement, build a road or dam or building, install a septic tank or drainage ditch — or work in any way with soil materials — needs to know the kind of soil," Sutton said. "And the soil survey is a good source of information."

City and County officials, zoning and planning commissions, health departments, public works departments, garden clubs, and similar organizations are using information about soils. The soil survey provides a basis for planned use and development in the best interest of the public, according to Sutton.

Included in the leaflet is a map of the state, showing the status of published soil surveys in each county. It gives the date each map was published, together with an estimate of the detail shown and general usefulness of the map.

Except for a few of the earlier ones which are out of print, the published surveys can be obtained from the Soils Department, North Carolina State College, Raleigh. Those published since 1956 may also be obtained from local Soil Conservation Service offices in the counties concerned, and from the county agricultural agents. Soil maps of

individual farms are furnished by the Soil Conservation Service to cooperators of soil and water conservation districts who have started development of a farm conservation plan.

Mars Hill College Will Begin Historic Year Next Week

MARS HILL—Orientation and the week. Classes will begin at registration for what promises to be an historic year at Mars Hill College will begin Tuesday (Sept. 10) and continue through Sept. 16. Numerous changes and improvements will greet approximately 1,230 students expected. After more than five years of careful planning the 108-year-old Baptist institution becomes a full-fledged liberal arts senior college. The first senior class will comprise 150 students. There will be nearly \$600,000 worth of physical improvements to the campus ready when the term begins, the student body

will be 10 per cent larger than at this time last year, the faculty will be enlarged and improved and there will be a host of new courses and related innovations.

Most striking of the physical improvements is a new half-million dormitory for women. Named in honor of Mr. and Mrs. C. G. Fox of Hickory, the four-story structure will provide accommodations for 115 coeds, a hostess and the dean of women.

Other improvements include a new home management house for the home economics department and several labs, classrooms and storage spaces in the science building. A new football stadium and gridiron also are beginning to take shape.

The addition of the senior year's courses and an enrollment increase of about 109 have necessitated expansion of the faculty. Eighteen new teachers have been employed, only six of them replacements. The other 12 are additions, bringing the teaching corps total to 73. New courses in all 13 of the school's departments have been planned.

Other additions and improvements to campus life include (1) inauguration of a program of practice teaching by the education department, (2) opening of a student placement bureau, (3) a new student government, (4) a soon-to-be-announced ranking of the faculty, (5) assignment of dormitories by classes, (6) a trial plan of open stack library privileges for seniors and (7) a new procedure in the cafeteria to replace the recently discontinued mealbook plan.
