VINCENT EDWARDS is now entering his third year as the most famous neurosurgeon in the country, "Ben Casey." Is he happy with the role that overnight turned him from a Nobody into a Somebody? Yes and no. Edwards explains, "The life that Dr. Ben Casey gave me is a double-edged sword. On one side it is great, big, shiny, highly honed plus and on the other there are some major nicks, very jagged and more than somewhat rough. Take recognition. It's great when it reaches a certain point but not so good when it gets out of hand, when the part dominates the actor. Every actor knows he is in trouble if and when he becomes hopelessly typecast." To avoid this, Vince has branched out into the entertainment world by appearing in a feature film, cutting three albums and starring in his own act at a Las Vegas nightclub. This year, Edwards plans to continue his battle against the Casey "image" by being "busy as ever on all of the other fronts."

I'm fascinated with the creative aspect of movie making, but as an actor, there's so much I hate about the process, so much wasted time... it's a director's medium. I took 'Lilith' because there's only one thing I'm really concerned with here—the director. (Robert Rossen) can make a great movie... I have confidence in what ever he takes a crack at. I want to be a part of it."
