To be entitled to a monthly retirement benefit in January 1940 one had to be at least 65 years old. "So, after receiving monthly checks for 25° years," Michols went on, "such an individual would now be at least 90 years old - and most likely older. Therefore it is a very small and select group indeed who received their 300th social security check on January 4. By their work and payment of social socurity taxes at the very beginning of the program they earned the right to these benefits. We! take off our hats to them."

In addition to this 25th anniversary of monthly benefit payments now celebrated, 1965 will also mark the 30th anniversary of the Social Security Act, which was signed by President Franklin D. Roosevelt in August 1935.

Nichols stated that beneficiaries under the old-age and survivors insurance program, as well as the disability insurance program which was added in 1954, have rece ved benedits totaling more than \$114 billion from January 1940 to the present. Monthly benefit payments made during that first year, 1940, were just over \$15 million, and went to 102,941 aged workers, the'r dependents, and survivors.

"The social security program as a whole has shown a steady growth during this 25-year period. Benefits paid during the 1964 fiscal year, from July 1963 through June 1964, totaled II5.8 billion. At the end of 1984, over 20 million people were receiving monthly benefit


