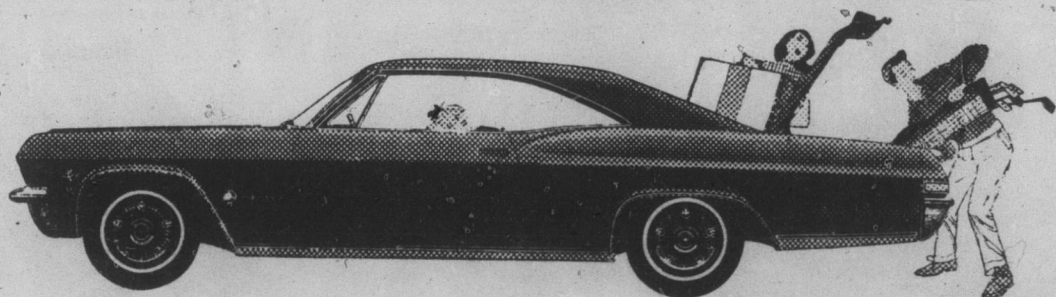

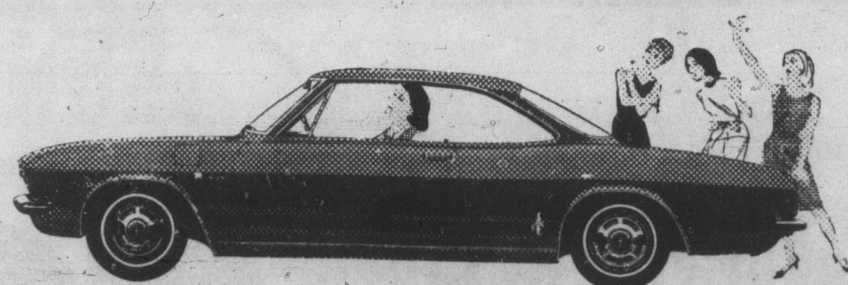
'65 Chevrolet Impala Sport Coupe

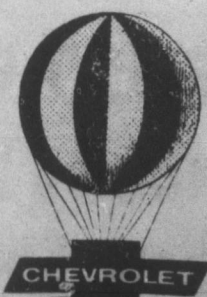
