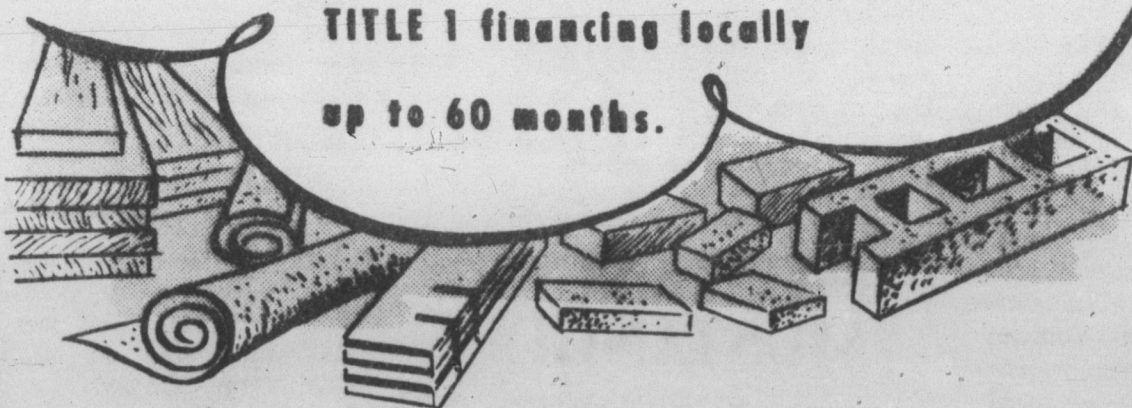

Civil Service Exams To Be Given

The Board of U. S. Civil Service Examiners at the VA Hospital, Oteen, North Carolina, announces a new examination for Stenographer, GS-3 (4005) and GS-4 (4480). Applications will be accepted if postmarked by midnight May 17, 1965.

A written test is required. Tests will be given at the Post Offices in Asheville and Sylva. The register resulting from this examination will be used by appointing officers of Federal agencies in the Western counties of North Carolina, westward to the Tennessee line and eastward to Catamba County.

The current Typist register kept by the Board will remain in use, the Executive Secretary announced. No new examination for Typist is being opened.

Yancey Streams Restocked

In accordance with previously approved plans, the Wildlife Resources Commission has completed stocking of 1,200 trout averaging 8 to 10 inches in length, in the waters of Yancey County. These fish were produced at the Federal Fish Hatchery located near Pisgah Forest. District Game & Fish Protector Mr. D. R. McGalliard directed the release of the fish and solicited assistance from members of the local wildlife club and other interested sportsmen. Participating in the stocking was W. E. Gooden, Wildlife Patrolman.

The Wildlife Resources Commission points out that the cooperative effort of all those interested in the State's fish and game resources will be required to bring about better fishing, the favorite outdoor recreation of so many Americans.
