The following is a sampling of the books recently added by the Avery-Mitchell-Yancey Regional Library. They may be obtained through the public libraries in Newland, Bakersville Spruce Pine or Burnsville or any of the bookmobiles operated in the three counties.

**NO SLIPPER FOR CINDERELLA** by Mildred Lawrence. The heroine, Merial Chapin, thought she was in dire need of a fairy godmother; but it wasn't either pumpkins or magic wands which transformed Merial.

**THE TWIN SERPENTS** by Ronald Scott Thorn. The pace mounts from page to page in this suspenseful and highly literate thriller, which gives a new twist to the coiled serpents climbing the rod of Mercury, long the emblem of physicians and surgeons.

**A CARIBBEAN MYSTERY** by Agatha Christie. A short "Miss Marple" novel. Most of the readers of Agatha Christie will in the end ask themselves how they could have been so blind—or how Agatha Christie could have fooled them again.

**SHADOW OF A MAN** by Doris Miles Disney. In her latest novel she demonstrates the versatility that has made her one of the most exciting and talented writers in the field of mystery fiction.

**THOMAS** by Shelley Mydans. A novel of the life, passion and miracles of Becket, one of the most complex religious and political figures of the Middle Ages. His brilliant life and notorious murder are masterfully re-created in this distinguished novel.

**SECOND SPRING AND TWO POTATOES** by Ilka Chase. An amusing journey to the South Seas, Australia and South Africa, with photos.

**THE WASTED AMERICANS**. Edgar May, a Pulitzer-prize-winning journalist, looks deep into our welfare problems to see why millions of Americans are living on relief in the middle of affluence.

**THE ACCIDENTAL CENTURY** by Michael Harrington. The issue is not, he argues, whether the future will be radically different from the past, rather HOW it will differ. If the Accidental Century is made purposive by the political intervention of man, then the various decadences described in this book will be, like the waning of the Middle Ages, the prelude to a Renaissance.

**IT'S YOUR COMMUNITY!** by Henry B. Raymore and H. Stuart Cartloff. What YOU can do and HOW you can do it to make your town a better place to live in.

**Spruce Pine Hospital  
Begins Public  
Relations Program**

**SPRUCE PINE** — At the regular monthly meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Spruce Pine Community Hospital a joint Public Relations and Security Program was unanimously approved. The program which will be completely implemented on or about the 15th of November is the results of a six weeks study by the Public Relations Committee; consultation with the Director of Nurses and Administrator as well as staff physicians.

R. T. Dent, Chairman of the Public Relations Committee told the Board of Trustees "that the problem of too many visitors is not unique to the Spruce Pine Community Hospital and many instances have occurred through-out the state where well meaning persons have interrupted medical treatment and inadvertently kept patients from getting the rest prescribed by their doctors".

The following is the resolution unanimously adopted by the Board of Trustees.

**WHEREAS:** The Spruce Pine Community Hospital Incorporated is a non profit corporation dedicated to the promotion of health and welfare of its patients, it has become necessary to institute certain rules and regulations regarding visitations at the hospital for the benefit and protection of its patients who are its primary responsibility, and that we the Board of Trustees respectfully ask for the cooperation of the public in abiding by these regulations, deemed to be reasonable and necessary, in order that the corporation fulfill its legal and moral responsibility to the public.

Additional news releases will be made within the next three weeks to advise the public of this new program.
