

In the boys game with Harris High, the Rebel boys lost to the Spruce Pine team by nine points with a score of 62-53.

Although the Cane River team lost, Hill kept the hoop warm by dropping in 26 of the 53 points scored by the Rebels. Wilson followed with 10 points, with Laws 6, McCurry 5, Proffitt 4, and Tipton 2.

At Marshall Tuesday night the Cane River teams lost both hard fought games to the strong Marshall High teams:

The Marshall girls made a final stand with a ten point lead, ending the game 42-32.


Cox of the Rebels again led the scoring for the local team with 14 points. Fox and Ballou tied with 7

points each, and King and Allen scored 2 points each. At Marshall the Cane River boys lost a heart-breaker. At the end of regular play the score was 73-73.
