The present building serves as a center for the Home Demonstration Club, Scouts, 4-H and other groups in addition to the regular meeting place for the community club.

Emphasis in the Community Development Program is being extended to communities that have not previously been organized. This is part of the expanded program made possible by the addition of an Assistant Extension Agent Kenneth Sanchagrin and Mrs. Patricia Anderson, secretary.
