Raleigh, N. C. — The General Board of the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina has named Sam H. O'Neal Secretary of the Training Union Department. He succeeds the late Mr. James P. Moran. Prior to this Mr. O'Neal has served as an associate in the department for five years.

Before coming with the Training Union Department, he served as pastor of the following North Carolina churches: Pleasant Grove, Rutherfordton, 1955-1957; Pleasant Grove, Ronda, 1957-1960; Rich Fork, Thomasville, 1960-1961.

While in Rutherfordton, the church was named "Rural Church of the Year" in 1955 by the Baptist State Convention. In 1956 it received the same honor by the North Carolina State Grange. While in Ronda, the church was named "Rural Church of the Year" by the North Carolina State Grange. In 1957 Mr. O'Neal was the recipient of the "Outstanding Mountain Minister" Award given annually by the Clear

Creek Baptist School in Pineville, Kentucky. He is the graduate of Gardner-Webb College, Limestone College, and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary. Before entering the ministry he was with the J. C. Penney Company serving as assistant manager in the Martinsville, Virginia store.

Mr. O'Neal is married to the former Lucille Combs of Elkin. They are the parents of one son, T. Shawn, age 6.

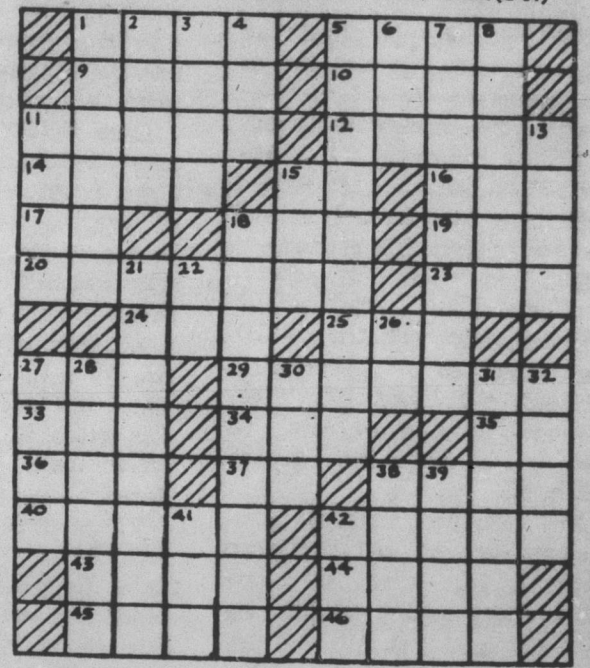
