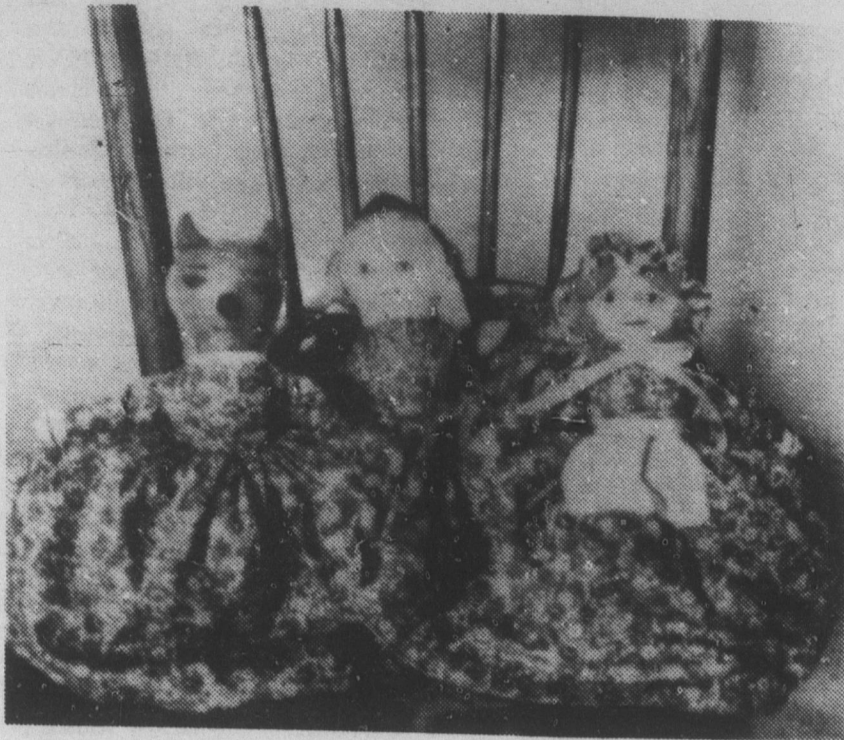


Women Learn To Make Dolls In Craft Workshop

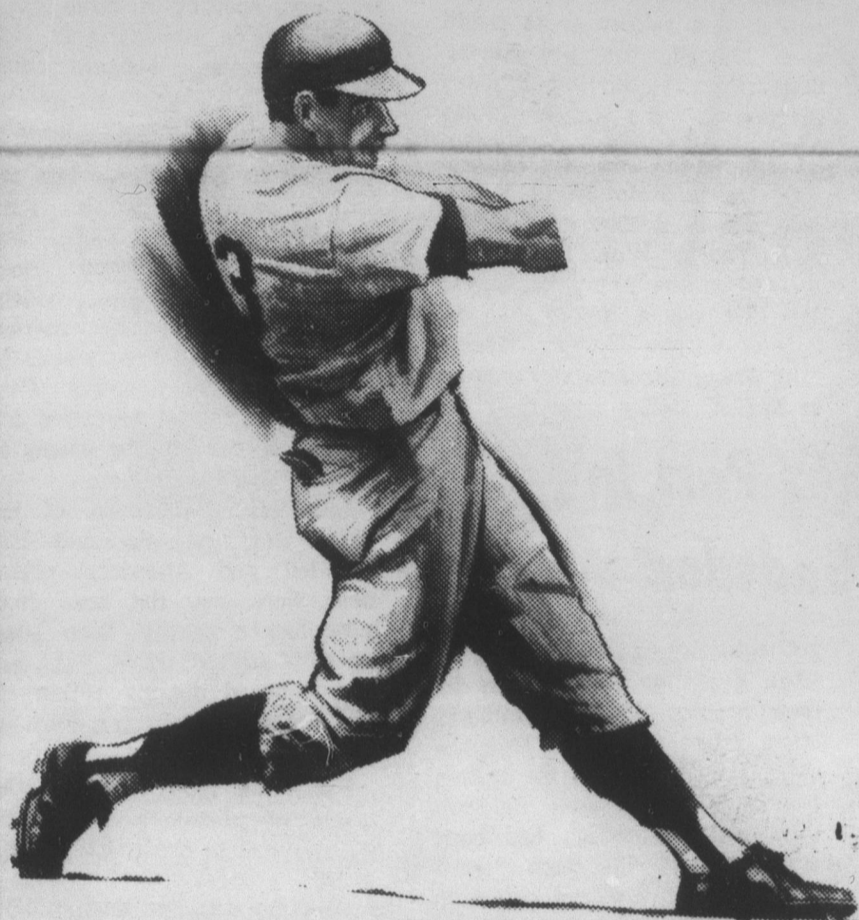
Plans Made For Basic Electrical Class
