

NOTICE OF SALE OF LAND

That tract or parcel of land situate about 9 miles East of Burnsville, North Carolina, in Crabtree Township, County of Yancey and State of North Carolina, said tract having such shape, metes, courses and distances as shown by map thereof made pursuant to survey by S. G. Hall, Surveyor, April 23, 1967, bounded now or formerly on the North by the lands of Fred

Howell and Clarence Howell; on the East by the lands of

Charlie Gurley; on the South by the land of Lew's Gurley heirs, and on the West by the land of Sam Greene and described as follows:

BEGINNING on a Black Oak, corner of the Sam Greene, Fred Howell and Clarence Howell tracts, and runs thence South 43 degrees East 718 feet to a Chestnut stump; South 60 degrees 30 minutes East 1538 feet to a Cucumber; thence South 20 degrees 30 minutes West 333 feet

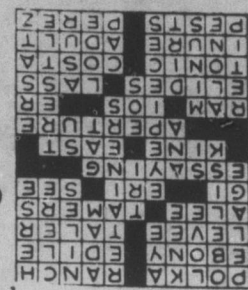

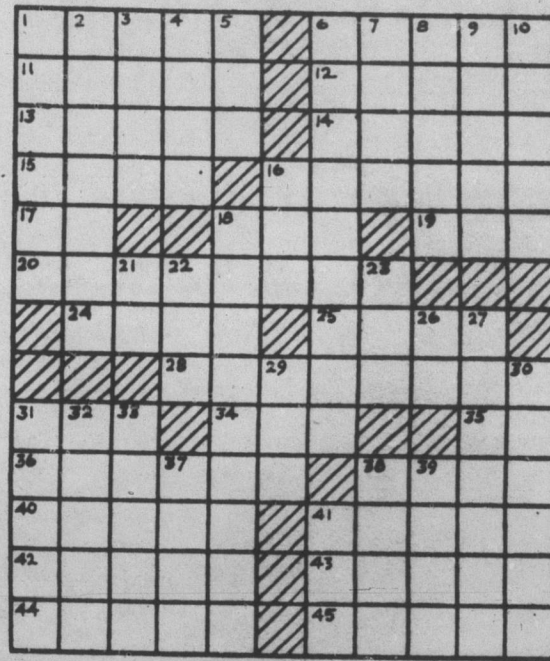
