**Census Bureau
To Make
Survey**

During the week of June 18, the Census Bureau will make a survey of households equipped with television, according to Director Joseph R. Norwood of the Census Regional Office in Charlotte. The survey will be taken in this area and in 448 other areas throughout the U. S.

Sponsored by the Federal Communications Commission and

the Advertising Research Foundation, the TV survey will provide National estimates on the number of households equipped with color, black and white, and ultra high frequency sets.

The special questions on television will supplement the Bureau's monthly survey of employment and unemployment to provide monthly measures of the employment situation for the Department of Labor's Bureau of Labor Statistics. The identity of the households participating in the survey will be kept confidential by law and facts obtained will be used only to obtain statistical totals.
