Robertson strongly advised all such Medicare beneficiaries to get in touch with us without delay, since there is a time limit for filing these claims for benefits unler Part B of Medicare. Particularly for medical expenses incurred in 1966 this time limit is fast approaching."

He explained that as a general rule cla'ms for paymen' must be filed "no later than the end of the calendar year following the year in which the medical services are furn'shed."

He reminded Medicare beneficiaries that in general they are responsible for the first \$50 othe deductible" of covered expenses m the year Med care will then pay 80% St out of \$50 of the remaining reasonable charges

"Because of a special rule, called the "corry-over rule," seme perple do not even have to have medical expenses tetaling \$50 to file a claim for paymen: This rule is explained on Page 21 of your green Medicare Handbook

"If you have any question as to whether certain melical expenses are, or are not, covered by Med care - or if you simply den't know how to file a claim for payment, or have de'ayed filing for any other reason get in touch with our office now.


