Scott Advocates Paved Driveways For Fire Departments

Lt. Gov. Bob Scott, Democratic candidate for governor, has suggested the State should pave driveways leading to volunteer fire departments.

"I believe where it's practical and feasible, the State should pave the driveways of these fire stations," Scott said. "The trucks need to move out quickly and safely in order to save lives and property."

Scott said volunteer departments effectively reduce insurance rates. "Volunteer firemen are good citizens and contribute collectively thousands of man hours of time each year," he explained.

There are more than 750 volunteer fire departments in the State. Last year more than 18,000 volunteers attended training classes sponsored by the Community College system.
