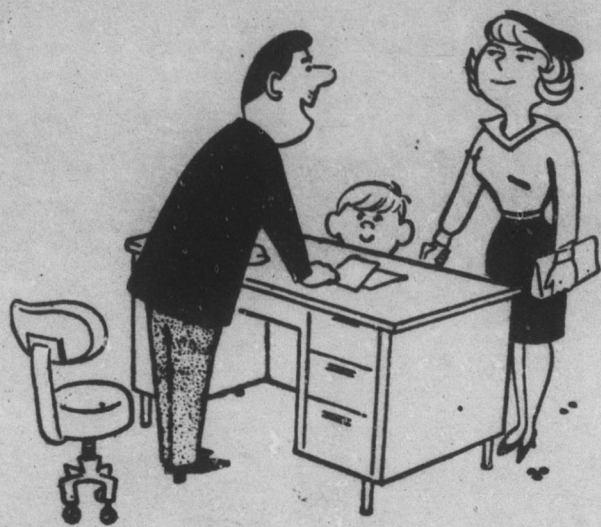


SOCIAL SECURITY

Questions
And Answers

Q. One of my neighbors tells me that when I'm ready to file a social security application I should "dial and file." He says it's a fast new service for filing claims. If he's right, please explain it in plain English and tell how it will help me.

A. He's right. "DIAL 'N FILE" is the tested telephone claims filing service of the Asheville Social Security Office. It saves applicants trouble, time and money, and speeds up their first benefit checks.

It's a simple, easy, convenient, time-saving service you or anyone can use to file for Retirement and Dependent's, Death or Survivors' benefits — or for Medicare coverage at age 65.

When you're ready to file a claim you simply call the Asheville DIAL 'N FILE number 254-3121.

When you telephone, the social security specialist will ask you a few questions, will tell you what records or proofs to furnish (and, if necessary, how and where to get them), and what other actions are needed to complete your claim so it can be sent promptly to the Payment Center.

DIAL 'N FILE 3 months before

- (1) You retire—if 62 or over
- (2) You're 62 — if retired — not having high earnings
- (3) You're 65 — even though not retired — to file for Medicare coverage
- (4) You're 60 — if a widow.

Also DIAL 'N FILE after the death of a worker covered by social security.

REMEMBER — call the Asheville DIAL 'N FILE number

254-3121 to file applications only. For information or any other social security service, dial 252-8773. (You may want to clip this out for future use.)

Q. I'll be 62 in about two months and would like to file a claim, but I do not have a birth certificate. I've found several records of my age and can get more. Should I wait and get the other records before I apply?

A. No, you should apply now and let the social security specialist decide if you need more evidence of age. They can advise you and, if necessary, help you get any additional evidence that may be needed.

We suggest you "DIAL 'N FILE" (see above explanation).

Q. How old, and how disabled, must a disabled widow be before she can get benefits on her deceased husband's social security record? And if I decide to file such a claim, what will I need to take with me to the Social Security Office?

A. A disabled widow must be between 50 and 60 years old, and too disabled to do "any gainful work."

If you plan to apply as a disabled widow you should bring the following to our office: Your deceased husband's social security card or number, your own social security card, your marriage record, your husband's death certificate if you have it, and some good record(s) or document(s) showing your age. If you think you're eligible you should contact us even if you haven't got all this information. Don't delay.

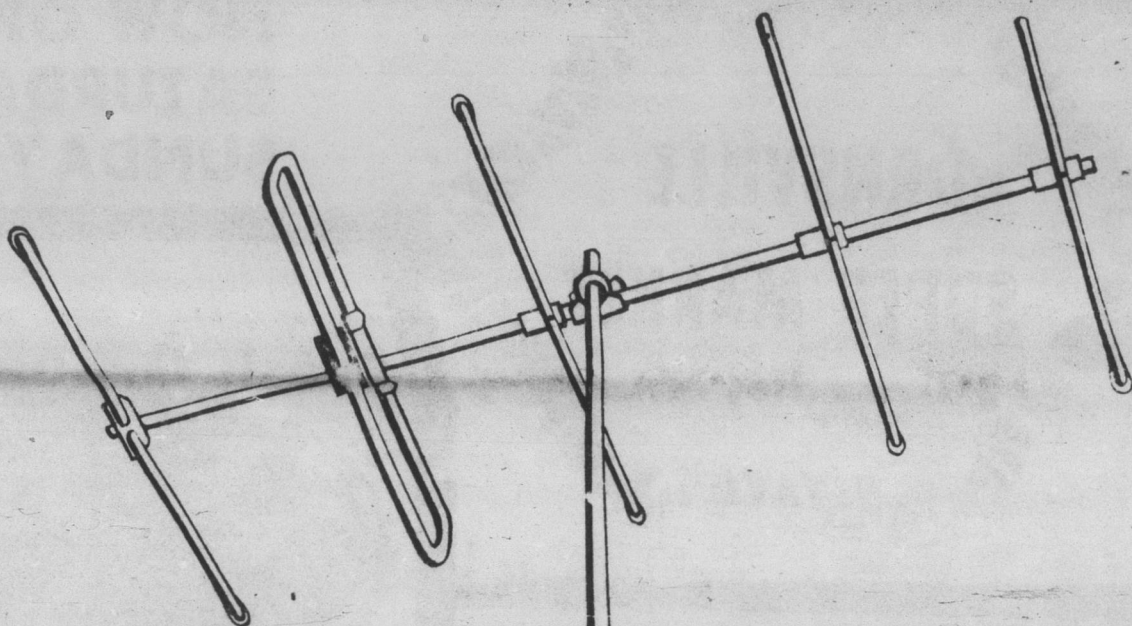
