Forest Service Eliminating Recreation Area

Peter J. Hanlon, Forest Supervisor, National Forest in North Carolina has announced that the Forest Service is eliminating Big Ivy Recreation Area near Barnardsville, N. C.

"This decision", said Hanlon, "has been made two years after receiving approval to e'imina e the area. In the meantime, efforts have been directed towards protecting the area from vandalism and making it sate and enjoyable for the public. Help from some local people and State and Federal law enforcement offices hasn't sufficiently curbed vandalism and disturbances."

Summing up, Hanlon said:
"The Forest simply cannot invite the public to an area where their safety and enjoyment are not reasonably assured. Neither can a public agency disproportionately spend funds on a small recreation area when the funds are badly needed and can be more wisely spent elsewhere."
