**NOTICE OF SALE**

The Clerk of the Superior Court having directed the undersigned Commissioners to resell the property hereinafter described therefore the said Commissioners will on the 27th day of February, 1970 at 10:00 A.M. at the courthouse door in Burnsville, N.C., sell to the highest bidder for cash that tract or parcel of land situate in Crabtree Township, Yancey County, North Carolina, adjoining the lands of Lat R. Young and others and described as follows:

BEGINNING on a chestnut oak, Northwest corner of Lat R. 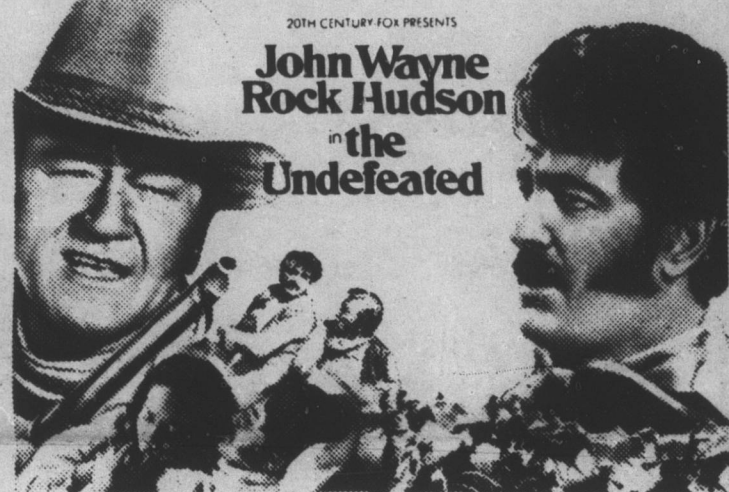
