The first question people ask me is what is a registered Quarter Horse. Many people in this area call anything that isn't a walking horse, rocking horse or plow horse, a Quarter horse.

Quarter Horse is a breed all its own and it is fast becoming the most popular breed in the United States. A quarter horse was so named because he can outrun any horse for a quarter of a mile, thus the name Quarter Horse arose. He is not - ed for his easy way of going

and for his gentle disposition. He makes an excellent baby sitter, a great barrel horse, he'll work cows, and one can Show the Quarter Horse English and Western Pleasure. The Quarter Horse is fast replacing the Thoroughbred in Hunt and Jumping Class and more than half of the horses on the United States Equestrian Team today are registered Quarter Horses.

Quarter Horse racing is becoming very popular in the United States and every year more and more thoroughbred tracks are being made available to these muscled little horses.

North Carolina is a little slow in coming to know these versatile little horses, but we do have 5 registered Quarter Horses here in Yancey County to my knowledge. These are: Peppi Conni, owned and shown

by Danny Hughes (son of Mr. Herman Hughes of Burnsville; Poco Somethin', a year-old halter filly owned by Mrs. Judy Mervolion of Pensacola; "Leo's Barbi", owned by Mr. and Mrs. B. Dotson of Miami; Peppi Dilly, owned and shown by Miss Carolina Yeager of Burnsville and a new addition to Burnsville, Junior Man - a 7-year-old Stallion owned and trained by Miss Carolina Yeager of Burnsville. Junior Man will stand at stud to approved non-reg. or registered mares this year. 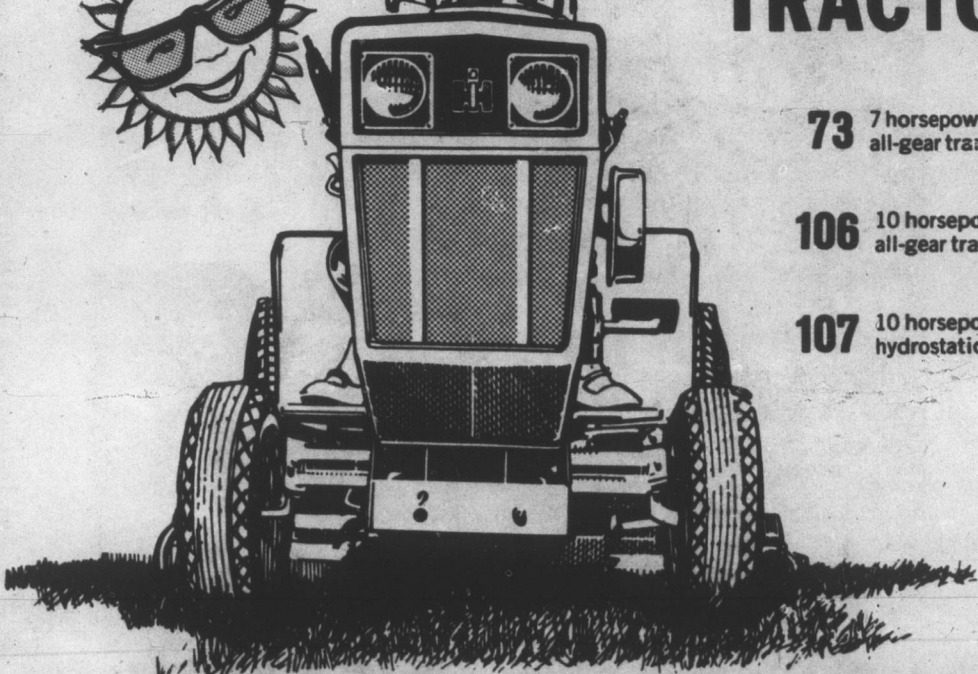
