NOTICE OF SPECIALELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special election will be held in the Town of Burnsville, North Carolina, on the 8th day of September, 1970, for the purpose of submitting the question whether the qualified voters of said Town shall approve the indebtedness to be incurred by the issuance of bonds of said Town of the maximum principal amount of \$230,000 to finance the improvement and enlargement of the system maintained by the Town to provide a supply of water to said Town and its inhabitants by the construction of a water reservoir together with the necessary water transmission mains including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required for the use of such reservoir as part of the Town's water system and the acquisition of the necessary lands or rights-in-land, and a tax to be levied for the payment thereof, and also the bond ordinance adopted by the Board of Commissioners of said Town on July 31st, 1970, which authorizes the issuance of said bonds for such purpose and the levy of such tax.

The ballots to be used at said election shall contain the words "FOR the ordinance authorizing \$230,000 of bonds to finance the improvement and enlargement of the system maintained by the Town to provide a supply of water to said Town and its inhabitants by the construction of a water reservoir together with the necessary water transmission mains including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required for the use of such reservoir as part of the Town's water system and the acquisition of the necessary lands or rights-in-land and a tax therefor" and the words "AGAINST the ordinance authorizing \$230,000 of bonds to finance the improvement and enlargement of the system maintained by the Town to provide a supply of water to said Town and its inhabitants by the construction of a water reservoir together with the necessary water transmission mains including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required for the use of such reservoir as part of the Town's water system and the acquisition of the necessary lands or rights-in-land and a tax therefor" with squares beside the words "FOR" and "AGAINST" in one of which squares the voter may make an (X) mark to indicate his choice.

In the event that the qualified voters approve the indebtedness to be incurred by the issuance of said bonds and the tax therefor and said ordinance, the bonds authorized by said ordinance will be issued for the purpose stated and an annual tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds will be levied.

The polls for said election will open at the hour of 6:30 o'clock, A.M., and will close at the hour of 6:30 o'clock, P.M., (Eastern Daylight Saving Time).

The polling place for said election shall be the usual polling place in the Town of Burnsville, namely: The Town Hall.

The Board of Commissioners has appointed John Wilson to act as Registrar and Mrs. Annie Bennett and Philip C. Ray to act as Judges of Election for said election. The Registrar will be furnished with the registration book used at the last regular election held in the Town of Burnsville (being the regular municipal election held on May 6th, 1969) and he will revise the registration book so that it will show an accurate list of the electors previously registered in the Town and still residing therein, without requiring such electors to register anew. The Registrar will keep the registration book open for the registration of new electors on each day (Sundays excepted) for the period beginning Friday, the 21st day of August, 1970 and ending on Friday, the 28th day of August, 1970. The book will be kept open on each Saturday during such period from 9 o'clock, A.M., until 9 o'clock, P.M., Eastern Daylight Saving Time

and other days during such period from 9 o'clock, A.M., until 5 o'clock, P.M., Eastern Daylight Saving Time. The registration book will be kept open at the polling place hereinafore named on Saturday, the 29th day of August, 1970, for the inspection of electors and any of such electors shall be allowed to object to the name of any person appearing on said book.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$230,000 OF BONDS OF THE TOWN OF BURNSVILLE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND ENLARGEMENT OF THE WATER SYSTEM MAINTAINED BY THE TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Burnsville, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of the Town of Burnsville has ascertained and hereby determines that it is necessary that said Town improve and enlarge the system maintained by the Town to pro-

vide a supply of water to said Town and its inhabitants by the construction of a water reservoir together with the necessary water transmission mains including the acquisition and installation of the equipment, machinery and apparatus required for the use of such reservoir as part of the Town's water system and the acquisition of the necessary lands or rights-in-land.

Section 2. Said Board of Commissioners has also ascertained and hereby determines that the purpose hereinbefore described is a necessary expense of said Town within the meaning of Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of North Carolina and is a purpose for which said Town may raise or appropriate money, and is not a current expense of said Town.

Section 3. In order to provide funds for such purpose, in addition to any funds which may be made available for such purpose from any other source, bonds of the Town of Burnsville are hereby authorized and shall be issued pursuant to The Municipal Finance Act, 1921, of North Carolina. The maximum aggregate amount of bonds authorized by this ordinance shall

be Two Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$230,000).

Section 4. A tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds shall be annually levied and collected.

Section 5. A statement of the debt of said Town has been filed with the Town Clerk of said Town, as required by said Act, and is open to public inspection.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect when approved by the voters of said Town at an election to be called and held as provided in said Act.

The foregoing bond ordinance was passed on the 31st day of July, 1970 and was first published on the 6th day of August, 1970.

Any action or proceedings questioning the validity of said ordinance must be commenced within thirty days after its first publication.

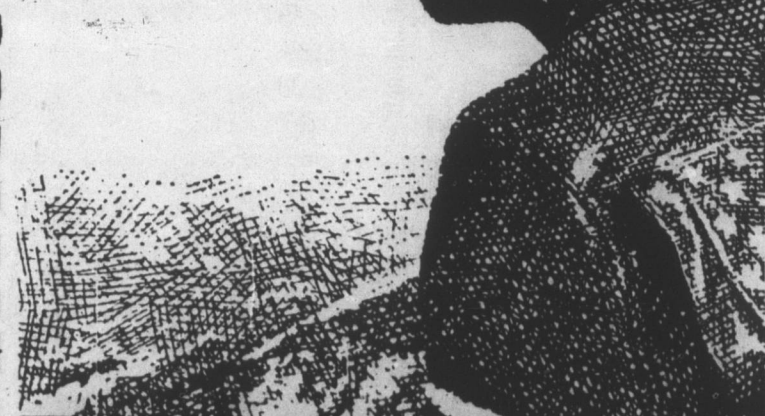
