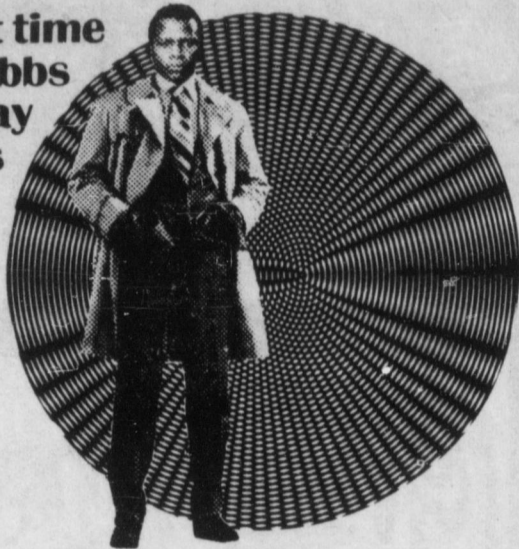

BEGINNING on N. 87 E. 68 poles to a White Oak, corner to the Higgins tract; thence with the line of said tract E. 21 poles to a Black Pine on a ridge; thence up said ridge with its same height N. E. 16 poles; N. 30 E. 26 poles to a small White Oak, corner of the said Higgins, on the top of Coopers Ridge; thence up the ridge with its main height N. 49 W. 20 poles; N. 70 W. 18 poles to a large White Oak on said ridge, corner of the Bill Beaver tract; thence down an intersecting ridge with the old Beaver line to the BEGINNING, containing 35 acres, more or less.
