The public is invited to attend and share in these services.

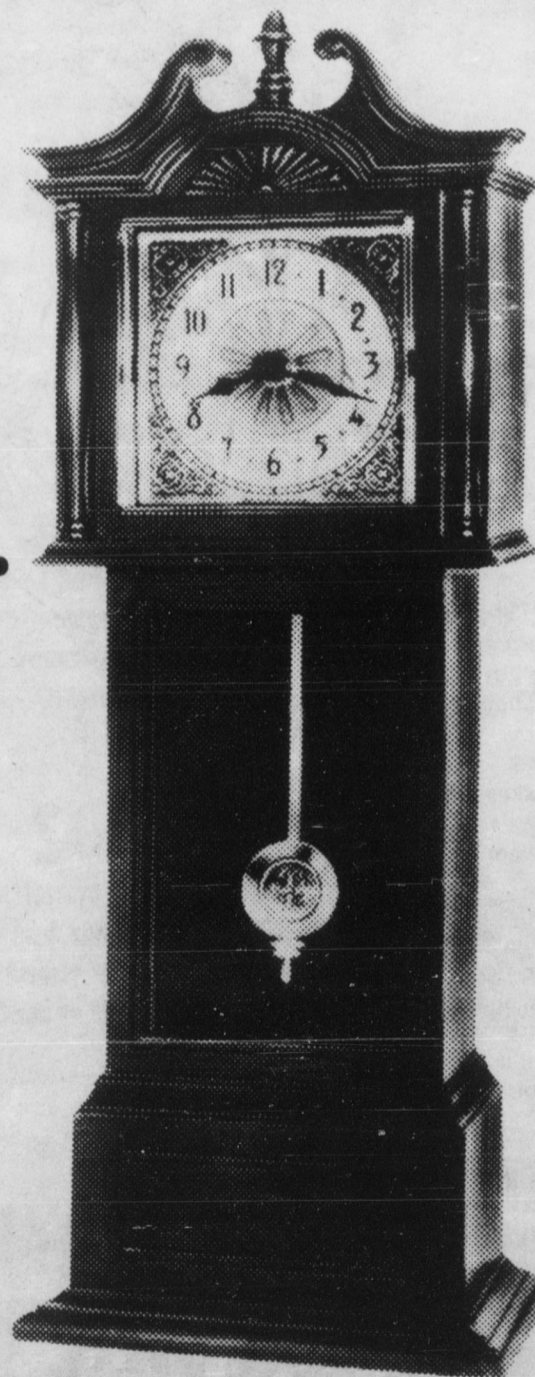
