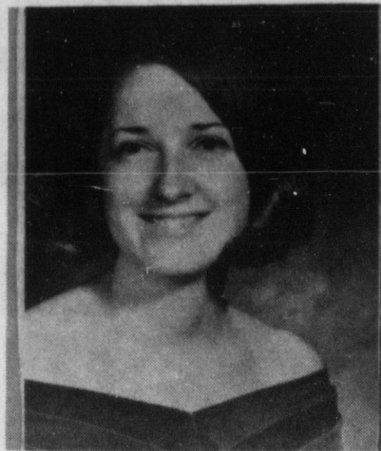

A 1971 graduating class of 221 students received degrees at Mars Hill College last week including several from Yancey County.

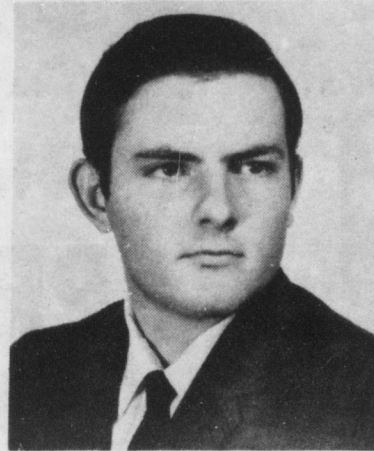
Russell Wayne Boone, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Leonard Boone of Burnsville, received a BS in chemistry and mathematics.
