Macrame' is a knot technique made by locking two yarn ends around one another

producing a geometrical pattern. It is one of the oldest types of fringe lace.

Types of articles made in Macrame' today include Mats, purses, bags, belts, wall hangings and many others.

Macrame' will be demonstrated during the Craftsman's Fair at the Extension Homemakers booth. Macrame' articles will also be on display.
