The reception was held at the home of the bride. Assisting in serving were Mrs. Earl Young and Mrs. James McIntosh, aunts of the bride. Mrs.



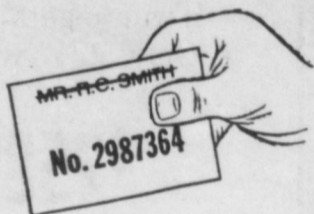
