A new book by a Burnsville author: *Jerry and the Missing Cuckoo*—has just come off the press. This book by Mrs. Joan Reeve is the moving story of a young boy who runs away from home. Two previous books by this author—*The Mystifying Twins* and *The Secret of the Mystifying Twins*, published in 1960 and 1961—have now sold around 85,000 copies.

Mrs. Reeve first started writing at the age of 8 or 9, but did not take it up seriously until she was blessed with beginner's luck when, after an overland trip from Japan to England, her article "Across Siberia" was sold the first time out. Since then numerous stories by Mrs. Reeve have been printed in Sunday School papers; but now she has found that she really prefers to write books. With 3 published ones to her credit, and a fourth due to come off the press next May, she still has 4 full length manuscripts ready to make
