Melissa was wearing a beautiful silver dress which was donated by the Thread & Needle Fabric Shop.

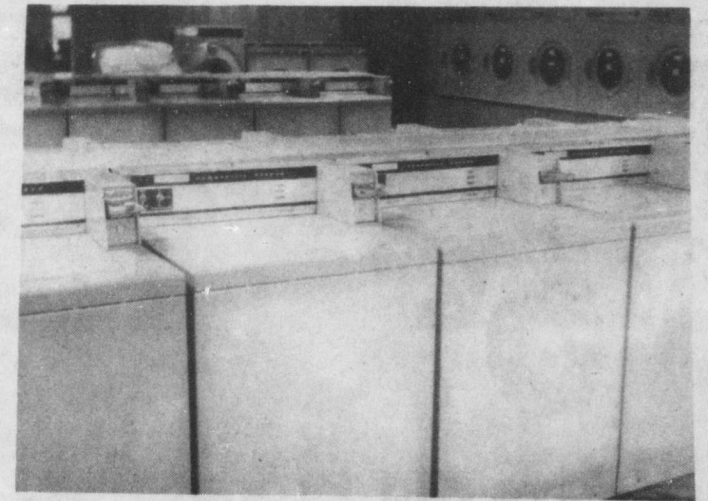
