Selected Campgrounds Will Open Early

According to Del Thorsen, Forest Supervisor of the National Forests in North Carolina, a few campgrounds on each district will be opened March 30. This will give the trout fisher men and early campers a place to stay, Thorsen said. The larger campgrounds which have sewage treatment plants and are more expensive to operate will be opened on May 25.

Interpretive services such as nature walks, illustrated evening talks and demonstrations will be gvailable at two of the campgrounds, Black Mountain and Jack Rabbit on May 25.

The Cradle of Forestry in America on the Pisgah District will open May 1. The Cradle is a reconstruction of the first forestry school in America. The campus has been recreated along a mile-long trail that winds through a pioneer mountain setting.

Fee collection will begin at designated campgrounds when the facilities open on a daily schedule. The "User Fee" for camping this year will be two dollars per camp unit, Day-use sites such as swimming areas will be one dollar per private noncommercial vehicle. 

VA Deadlines Announced Vietnam Era servicemen re-

turning to civilian life have key deadlines to remember. Here is the deadline time

In ten days, report address to Selective Service through local board. In thirty days, register with

Selective Service or any board veterans to: if not already registered. In ninety days, apply to

former employer for re-em ployment.

As soon as possible, register with local state employment service office. (Veterans have up to a year to apply for unemployment compensation but applications filed after a long period of unemployment could result in a lower rate of unemployment compensation).

In one-hundred twenty days, or one year if totally disabled at time of separation, convert Servicemen's Group Life Insurance (without examination) to private commercial policy.

Within one year, from date of notice of VA rating on disability, apply to any VA office for GI life insurance based on service connected disability. Within one year, apply to any VA office for dental care.

As soon as possible, apply to any VA office for GI education or training, which must be completed within eight years of separation from military. There is no time limit for

-- Apply to any VA office for a GI loan guaranty to buy a farm, or buy, build or improve


-- File claims with any VA office for compensation for service connected disease, or disabilities, or apply for hospital

-- Seek assistance from local offices of state employment service in finding employment or entering Labor Department job training programs.

All veterans assistance centers around the country are ready to help veterans get a quick start in civilian life.
