NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, of a hearing to be held by the Water and Air Quality Control Committee of the Board of Water and Air Resources, concerning the adoption of a regulation controlling the use of conical incinerators in the disposal of wood and agricultural waste. The hearing is scheduled to be held in the auditorium, State Highway Building, corner of New Bern Avenue and Wilmington Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, beginning at 10:00 A.M., EST, December 6, 1973.

The regulation to be considered includes proposed requirements for establishing controls on conical incinerators burning wood and agricultural waste under a stated time schedule; in particular, the elimination of airborne pollutants and the monitoring of ambient particulate concentrations.

All persons interested in the proposed regulation are invited to attend and participate in the hearing. Persons desiring to be heard should notify the Board in writing on or before the date of the hearing. Written statements concerning the proposed action may be presented at the hearing or filed with the Board within thirty (30) days following the conclusion of the hearing.
