Sealed proposals will be received by the Yancey County Board of Education in the office of the Superintendent, Burnsville, North Carolina, at 3:00 p. m., March 21, 1974, for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment entering into the work of the following projects:

Site Improvement for YANCEY COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL
Burnsville, North Carolina
All work will be included in a single Contract.

Complete plans, specifications, and contract documents will be open for inspection in the plan rooms of the Associated General Contractors of America, Inc., in Charlotte, North Carolina, Raleigh, North Carolina, Greensboro, North Carolina, and Greenville, South Carolina and Atlanta, Georgia (SCAN), Blue Ridge Contractors Association, Asheville, North Carolina, in the office of the Superintendent, Yancey County Board of Education, Burnsville, North Carolina, and in the office of Padgett and Freeman, Architects, Asheville, North Carolina. Plans may be obtained by those qualified and who will make a bid upon deposit of fifty dollars (\$50) in cash or certified check. The full deposit will be returned to those submitting a bonafide proposal, provided the plans and specifications are returned to the Architect in good condition within five days after the date set for receiving bids. Contractors desiring more than one set of plans will pay the cost of reproduction for extra sets and no refund will be made for these.

The project consists generally of grading, drainage, seeding, and road construction for the Yancey County High School Site.

All Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws.

Each prime contractor's proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit or a certified check drawn on some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation of an amount equal to not less than 5 percent of the proposal or in lieu thereof a bidder may offer a bid bond of five percent of the bid executed by a surety company licensed under the laws of North Carolina to execute such bonds, conditioned that the surety will, upon demand, forthwith make payment to the obligees upon said bond if the bidder fails to execute the contract in accordance with the bid bond, and upon failure to forthwith make payment, the surety shall pay to the obligee an amount equal to double the amount of said bond. Said deposit shall be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten (10) days after the award or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.

All prime contractors will be required to furnish performance bond for one hundred percent of the contract price. Payment will be made on the basis of ninety (90%) percent of monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of work. No bid may be withdrawn
