ORDINANCE AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONSUMPTION OR DISPLAY OF BEER OR WINE ON CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF BURNSVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

The Board of Commissioners of the Town of Burnsville, North Carolina, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to consume or display beer or wine while such person is upon any highway, road, street, or any public property or upon the grounds and premises of any service station, supermarket, store, office building, or any other business establishment in the Town of Burnsville, open to the general public that does not hold a valid state license allowing the consumption of beer or wine on the premises.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person while a driver or passenger in a vehicle to consume or display beer or wine while such vehicle is upon any highway, road, street, or any public property or upon the grounds and premises of any service station, supermarket, store, office building, or any other business establishment in the Town of Burnsville, open to the general public.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: Any person found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00), or imprisoned not more than 30 days, as provided by G.S. 14-4 and G.S. 153-9 (55).

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.

The foregoing ordinance duly passed on the 5th day of February, 1974, upon motion of R.K. Helmle, seconded by P.C. Coletta and all members of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Burnsville voting in the affirmative.
