Q. I'm thinking about having my monthly social security check sent directly to my bank for deposit to my account. Will social security send me a notice every month showing that my check has gone to the bank ... or will the bank send me a receipt for each check?

A. Social security will not send confirmation of payment. However, many financial organizations are mailing receipts for deposit of social security checks, and some are guaranteeing deposit on the 3rd of every month automatically. You should check with your bank to find out how they are handling direct deposit of social security checks.

Q. From some pamphlets I received from social security, was able to figure approximately the amount of the monthly social security payments I'll get when I retire at 62. I'm only 56 now. Is there any possibility this amount could change?

Any additional earnings you have could increase the amount of your monthly social security payments. Also, the law now provides for automatic increases in social security benefits as the cost of living rises. A. Yes, indeed. Only women who first become entitled to social security widow's benefits when they are 65 or older get monthly payments equal to the full amount their husbands would have received at 65. Since your mother is only 63, she's getting reduced payments.


