Programs Of Study

Three programs of study have been incorporated into the curriculum for students to follow at Mountain Heritage High School. All of these lead to the high school diploma. They are General, Advanced Academic, and Vocational. A student selects the program he desires to follow in the 9th grade and progresses with it year by year.

General Curriculum: This curriculum is designed for those students whose goal is to receive a minimum of a high school diploma and who may or may not be interested in continuing their education on a higher level.

Advanced Curriculum: This curriculum is designed for those students whose goal is to continue their academic studies beyond the high school level, or for those students who would not benefit from the General or Vocational Curriculum.

Vocational Curriculum: This curriculum is designed for those students whose goal is to develop skills in a given vocation or continue their studies in a vocational field beyond the high school level.

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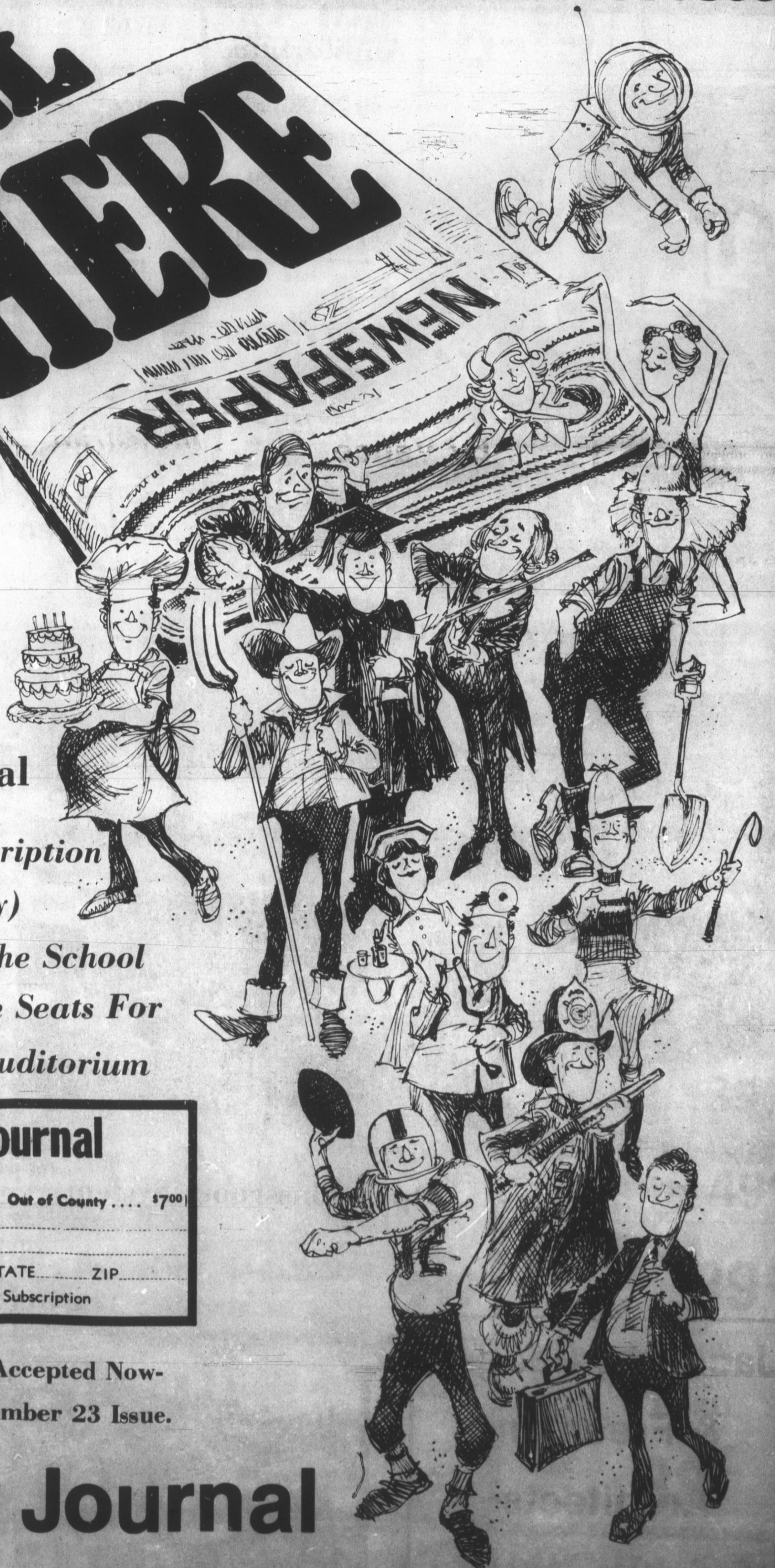
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
