Two members of the Burnsville Fire Department, Danny McIntosh and Jerry Laws, have just completed a course in the Handling of Hazardous Materials Emergency. The course was taught by Mr. Jeremiah J. O'Driscoll, CSP-Manager of Planning and Safety for the Southern Railway System, Atlanta, Georgia. The course was held at Western Piedmont Community College at Morganton, N.C.

The course took up the study of such items as High Explosives, Poisonous Gases and Corrosives and Radioactive Materials, to name just a few, which are transported each day by Railroad Tank Cars as well as Tanker Trucks through our area.

The course was designed to help Firemen and Rescue Personnel to know what to do in case of Emergency and how to handle the situation. They were taught the proper way to go about evacuating an area where a spill had occurred.

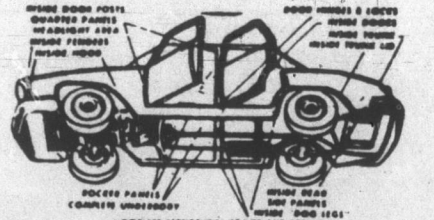
