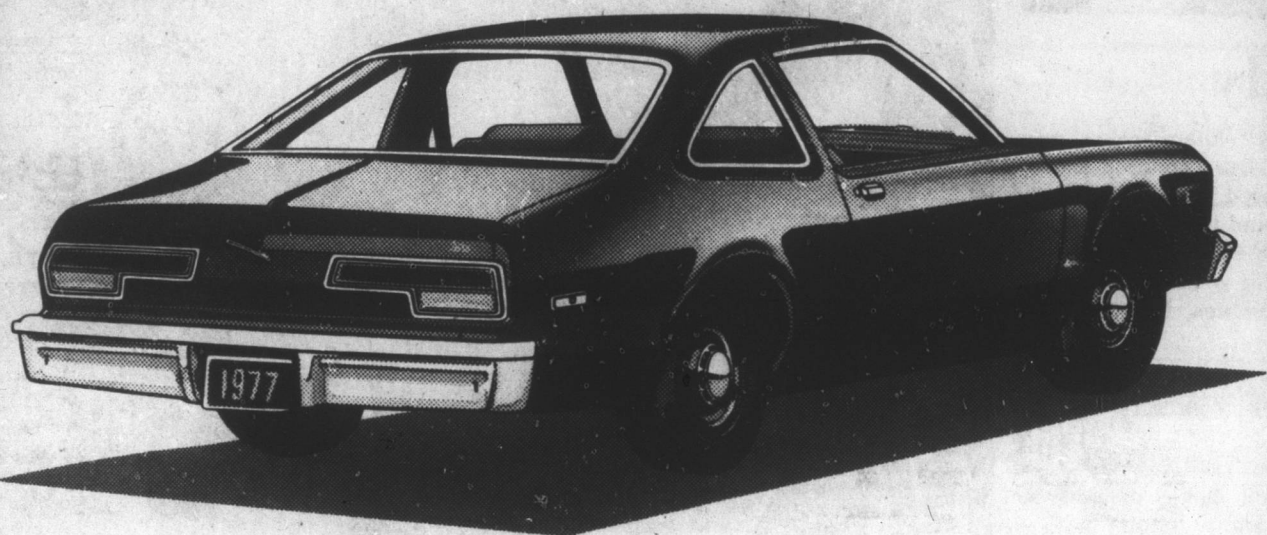

CHRISTMAS DIVINITY

- 3 cups sugar
- 2 egg whites
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1 cup chopped nuts
- 1/4 tsp. salt
- 1/4 cup water

1 (3 oz) pkg. cherry or lime jello

1/2 cup flaked coconut

1/4 cup light corn syrup

Butter sides of heavy 2 quart sauce pan. Add sugar, corn syrup, water and salt. Mix well. Cook until sugar dissolves and mixture comes to a boil. Cook to hard boil stage (250) without stirring. Remove from heat. Beat egg whites until soft peaks form. Gradually beat in dry gelatin until soft peaks form. Pour hot syrup slowly over egg whites beating constantly on high speed until soft peaks form. Add vanilla and stir in nuts. Drop by spoonfuls.
