For starters, if you are submitting above-average medical deductions try sending copies of documents (doctor bills, cancelled checks, etc.) with your tax returns to help verify your expenses. Also, know what to

deduct. Read the rules. Too many disallowables will increase your chances of getting audited. Remember to deduct only the amount in excess of 3% of your adjusted gross income.
