Proceeds of the new loan will be used to repay all outstanding long-term debt of the company and to provide additional working capital.

Indian Head Mills had long-term debt of \$19.9 million at

term debt of \$19.8 million at the close of its last fiscal year on December 2, 1961, most of which fell due in ap-proximately equal install-ments in 1962, 1963, and 1964. The portion due in 1962 was \$6.8 million. The new loan requires no repayments until 1965.

Working capital now stands at approximately \$25 million, up from \$15 million at the start of the fiscal year, and the ratio of current assets to current liabilities is now about 2.2 to 1, compared with 1.6 to 1 at the beginning of


