

NOTICE Town of Murphy PROPERTY

Upon motion by W.A. Singleton, duly seconded by Kenneth. Godirey, the following was unanimously passed by the Board: That an ordinance be adopted as follows for the regu-lation and control of the use of real property in the Towa of Murphy so as not to enroach upon rights and privileges of others or to cause depreciation of adjoining or nearby property owners. This ordinance to be effective June 1, 1963.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to erect any building or structure or to change the use of any building or structure or of anypiece of land without having first obtained a permit for same. The Mayor and Town Council shall appoint a Board to be known as the "Building and Property Use Board" con-sisting of three members of the citizens of Murphy whose duty shall be to study and review each permit request and to approve or deny such request. The Board shall be in-vested with full authority to make such decision. The Board shall have authority to call witnesses, hear petitions, to cause petitions to be advertised, to notify interested part-ies.

Violation or the existence of a violation each day shall constitute a separate violatios and subject to the same penalty. Failure of the board to act upon a petition within 30 days from date of receipt shall be considered approval unless the Board needs additional time to study the merid of the petition and the petitioner be so advised.
