Announces Addition
Of 286 Colleges

MURPHY - The Cherokee County Branch of the AAUW announces the addition of 286 colleges and universities to the list of AAUW qualified institutions by vote of the Association's Board of Directors late in November. Women graduates of these institutions will now be eligible for membership in the AAUW.

Some of the colleges from this area on the new list are: Appalachian State Teacher's College, Boone; Berry College, Mt. Berry, Ga.; Brenau College, Gainesville, Ga.; Carson-Newman College, Jefferson City, Tenn.; East Tenn. State College, Johnson City, Tenn.; High Point College, High Point, N. C.; Lenoir Rhyne College, Hickory, N. C.; Pfeiffer College, Misenheimer, N. C.; Scarritt College, Nashville, Tenn.; Tift College, Forsyth, Ga.; and Western Carolina College, Cullowhee, N. C.

"The American Association of University Women in Cherokee County," says Mrs. Ronald Ressel, president, "offers college women an opportunity to grow intellectually, to help further the advancement of women, and to discharge their social duties. The AAUW program," she explains, "centers on four areas of interest: Community Problems, Cultural Interests, Education and World Problems."

The Cherokee County Branch is developing these interests this year by focusing on a study of the Orient. The branch also supports the AAUW Fellowships Program, which awards about 100 fellowships each year, with stipends exceeding \$282,000, to women scholars from the United States and abroad for advanced study. In addition, the Association supports a legislative program voted by delegates to its biennial convention.

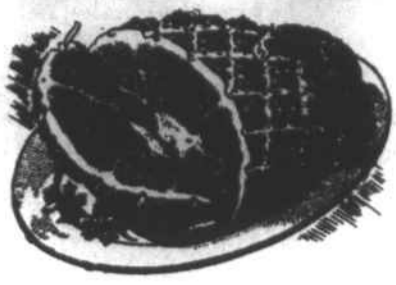

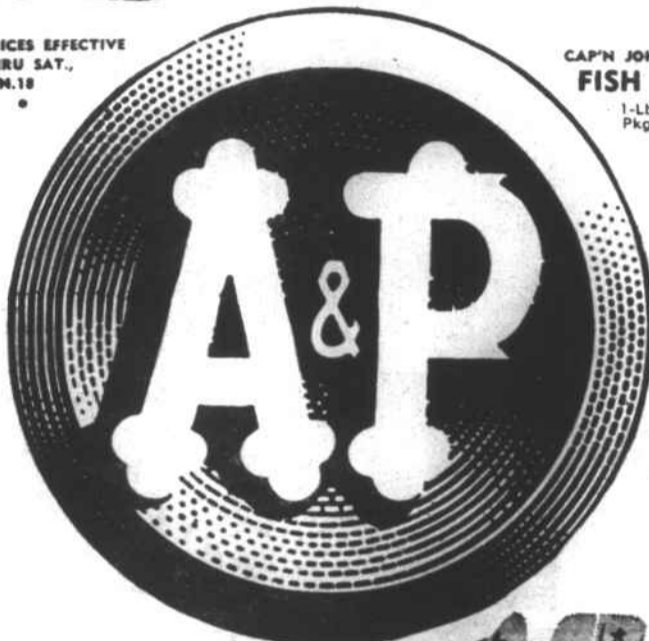

Nation In Germany

BAMBERG, GERMANY - Army Specialist Four Charles W. Nation, 22, son of Mr. and Mrs. Clyde Nation, Route 2, Murphy, and other members of the 109th Transportation Company participated in Exercise YELLOW WEDGE, a 4th Armored Division field training maneuver, near Bamberg, Germany, in early December.

In addition to testing the combat readiness of the 4th Armored and various units of the VII Corps which participated in the exercise, problems of communication and security involved in the large-scale troop movements were studied.

Specialist Nation, a truck driver in the company near Ludwigsburg, entered the Army in October 1959, and arrived overseas in March, 1960.

He attended Murphy High School and was employed at Hughes Esso Service Station before entering the Army. His wife, Wally, is with him in Germany.

Phillips Qualifies

U. S. FORCES, GERMANY - Army PFC Ralph W. Phillips, son of Frank C. Phillips, Route 1, Marble, qualified as expert in firing the submachinegun in Germany in mid-December.

Phillips, a tank driver in Troop B of the 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment's 1st Reconnaissance Squadron near Baumholder, entered the Army in June 1961 and arrived overseas in March, 1962.

U. S. FORCES, GERMANY - Army MSG Dargan Barnett, 45, son of George W. Barnett, Andrews, was assigned to the 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment in Germany, in mid-December.

Barnett, a platoon sergeant in the Regiment's Aviation Company near Hoppstadten, entered the Army in January, 1938. He was also assigned at Fort Bragg, N. C.

The sergeant's wife, Mary, lives in Fayetteville.
