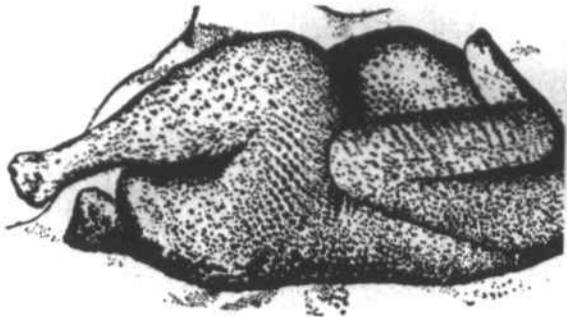

### Tips For Control Boxelder Bugs

 The boxelder bug is a common household nuisance in Cherokee County and North Carolina. Although they do not bite man, damage buildings, clothing or food, their presence is a nuisance.  
**DESCRIPTION**  
 Boxelder bugs are about 1/2 inch long and resemble squash bugs in body shape. The adult has three bright red lines running lengthwise on the thorax. There are also red markings on the front wings. Other parts of the body are dark brownish-gray to black.  
**HABITS**  
 Boxelder bugs seldom develop in numbers large enough to be a nuisance unless they are able to feed on female boxelder trees (also known as ash-leaf maple or three-leaf maple). However, boxelder bugs occasionally feed on ash, maple, and other trees. Boxelder bugs are most noticeable in the fall and on warm winter and early spring days. In the fall, they often enter homes and other protected places to spend the winter. On warm winter or spring days they come out into the open and appear in houses and on the sunny side of the houses on white or light painted surfaces.  
 When the boxelder trees bud in the spring, the bugs leave winter quarters and seek out female boxelder trees on which to feed and lay eggs.  
**CONTROL**  
 The only satisfactory and permanent method of control of boxelder bugs is the elimination of female boxelder trees. Planting only the male trees (which do not produce seed) will lessen the problem. A mixture of 2 1/2 gallons of dieldrin liquid concentrate (containing 1.5 lb. dieldrin per gallon) or 2 1/2 gallons of lindane 20% EC in 100 gallons of water sprayed on the trunks of boxelders in the summer prior to migration (when clusters of bugs appear on the bark) and repeated as needed will give some control of this pest. Spraying house foundations with the same materials may be of value.  
 Control is extremely difficult after boxelder bugs begin to migrate, have entered hibernation quarters, or temporarily emerge from hibernation during warm winter or spring days.

Approximately ninety percent of the students come from the Southern Appalachian area. The remaining ten percent includes those from other states and foreign countries. The college also maintains a secondary school program open to pupils below college level.
