



HABITS

Boxelder bugs seldom develop in numbers large enough to be a nuisance unless they are able to feed on female boxelder trees (also known as ash-leaf maple or threeleaf maple). However, boxelder bugs occasionally feed

Boxwelder bugs are most noticeable in the fall and on warm winter and early spring days. In the fall, they often enter homes and other protected places to spend the winter. On warm winter or spring days they come out into the open and appear in houses and on the sunny side of the phy High School. houses on white or light painted surfaces.

When the boxwelder trees bud in the spring, the bugs 5 leave winter quarters and seek out female boxelder trees on which to feed and lay eggs. CONTROL

2 33c of boxelder bugs is the elimination of female boxelder trees. Planting only the male trees (which do not produce seed) will lessen the problem.
