Mrs. Geoffrey Ramsell of Nottingham England, Pisgah Girl Scout Council's International Visitor for the next three weeks will be a special guest at a tea in Murphy on June 26 at 3 p.m. She will also visit Apple Tree Camp in the Nantahala Forest, site of the Girl Scout Eastern Roundup.

The British Visitor is one of the 64 adults and 150 girls representing 45 countries who will attend the Senior Roundup in Idaho in July. Each International Visitor will spend several weeks in a Girl Scout Council prior to going to Roundup. In Murphy she will meet Miss Naomi Sprung and Miss Sandra Cornwekk, two of the 16 Senior Girls from Pisgah Council who were chosen for the Roundup.

Mrs. Ramsell will serve as a staff member for the Senior Roundup in Idaho. She is a member of the Girl Guides association in Great Britain with experience in campcraft, exhibits, folk dancing, hiking, newspaper work, painting and song leading. The purpose of her visit which is partially financed by the Juliette Low World Friendship Fund, is to learn about Girl Scouting in the United States by observing girl and adult activities as they are carried on the Pisgah Council and to give the girls and adults of the Pisgah Council an opportunity to learn about Girl Guides in Great Britain.

The British visitor has been corresponding with Mrs. McLarty of Brevard, official hostess for the visit in this council, and her letters showed great interest and eagerness to know Girl Scouts in the United States. 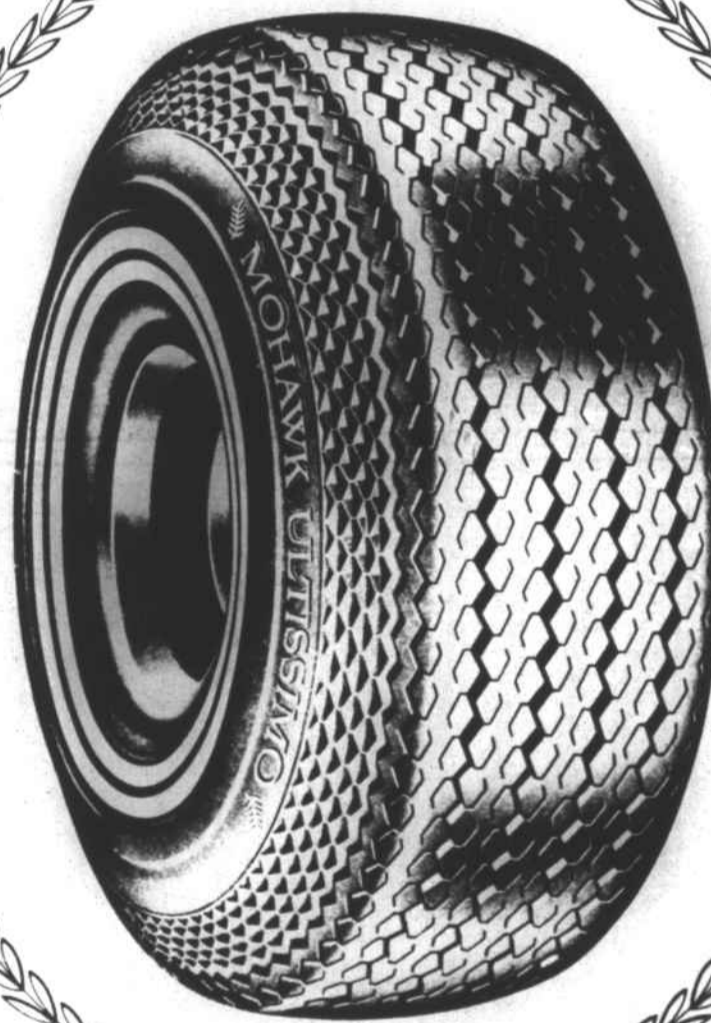
