Farmers Benefit From Pork Prices

RALEIGH - North Carolina farmers are getting the greater benefits from higher pork prices by taking an undisputed lead in swine production in the southeastern United States, according to livestock specialist and reports from the Cooperative Crop Reporting Service.

William W. Wilder, livestock marketing specialist with the N. C. Department of Agriculture, said that Tar Heel farmers are ahead of other states in two categories -- states with over 100,000 breeding swine and states with over 1,000,000 swine population - as compared with 1964.

"N. C. farmers show intentions of increasing the number of animals held for breeding by 17 percent over Dec. 1, 1964. This is the largest increase in the nation of states with over 100,000 breeding swine," Wilder reported.

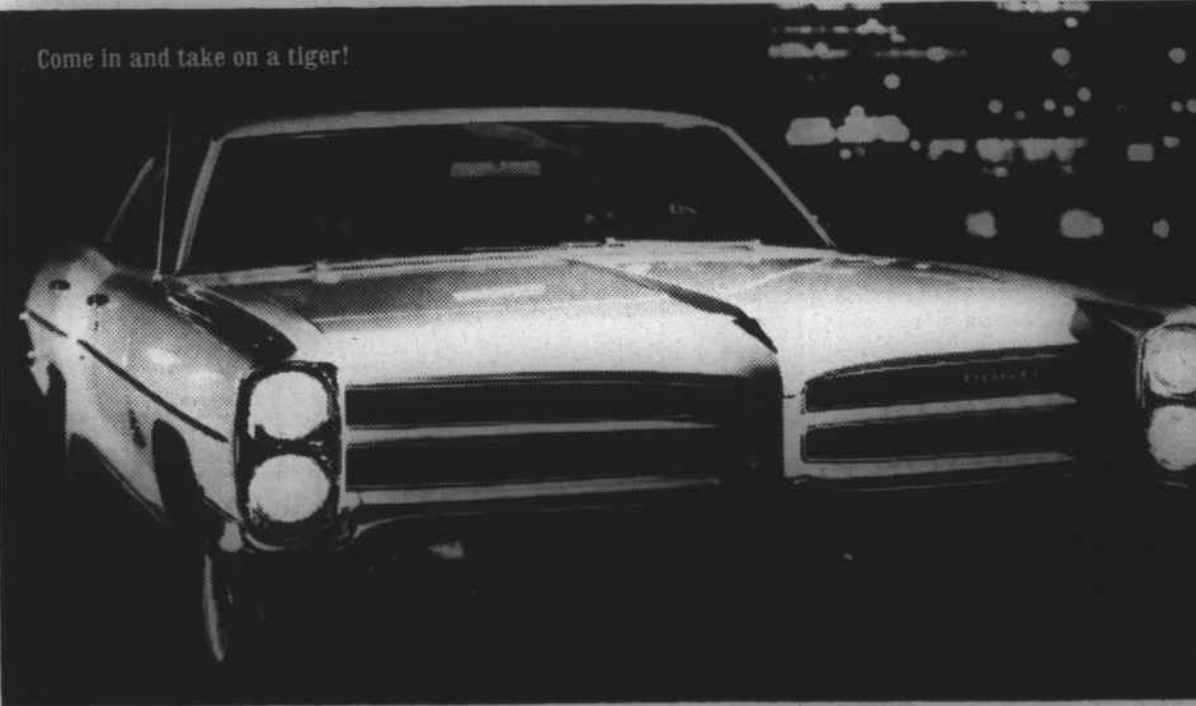
"Indications show that six percent more sows are expected to farrow during the Dec.
