

Clegg Bust Given To YHC

The Towns County and Clarksville, Ga. Lions Clubs presented a bust of Dr. Charles R. Clegg to Young Harris College yesterday.

The bust was created by Professor Abe W. Davidson, Chairman of the Art Department at Brenau College in Gainesville, Ga.

Lion H.O. Carlton, Director of the North Georgia Technical and Vocational School in Clarksville made the presentation. It was accepted by Dr. Raymond Cook, President of Young Harris College, on behalf of the school.

Two of Dr. Clegg's grandchildren, Lauren and Mark Clegg of Athens, Ga., unveiled the bust before the entire student body and many Lions from this area. Dr. Clegg served as president at Young Harris from 1950 until his death in 1963.

The bust is expected to be placed in the Clegg Fine Arts Building on the college campus.



Federal Employees In N. C. Urged To Buy Savings Bonds

O'Brien, Chairman of the Interdepartmental Savings Bonds Committee, on behalf of the Savings Bonds Division of the U.S. Treasury Department.

Mr. Johnson quoted Mr. Humphrey as follows: "Savings Bonds have a unique place in the history of our country. People all over this land feel a little closer to their Government when they have a bond that has the seal of the United States Government upon it. It is more than a piece of paper. It is a commitment on the part of

the citizen to his Government in this democracy, to the purposes of this nation, and to its present and its future. It's the wisest investment that anyone ever made, and when we ask one another to share

in this program, we are really asking one another to not only do better for our country, but to do better for ourselves."

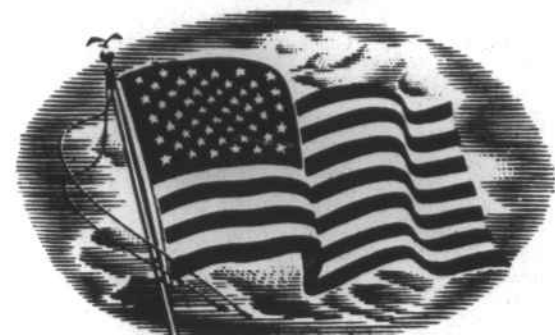

ITEM: When buying area or accent rugs, check the underneath as well as the top of the rug. These small size floor coverings need firm anchoring. If the rug is washable, the backing should also be washable. A backing of supple, fine-celled urethane (plastic foam) is both safe and washable.

ITEM: Pine tip blight is a fungus disease that disfigures Scotch, red, Austrian and mugho pine and balsam fir. The casual organism grows through the needles and destroys twig tissues. By mid-summer tips of branches begin dying. Tree experts recommend spraying of pine buds as they open, applying a copper fungicide. If spring is wet, a second application 10 days later and a third at equal interval may be necessary. Spray when the new candles of growth are pale green.

ITEM: You can walk at least four miles and spend 25 hours of your time during one year in making just one bed by the common dash-around method. Why not learn to make one side completely, then the other side? You'll find you can cut your time and effort used in bedmaking.

ITEM: Scrub the undersides of scatter rugs occasionally with heavy suds to remove dust and wax. Only clean backing can grip the floor securely.
